How to run TerraView in Linux using Wine?

- First, download the latest version of TerraView installer from

<http://www.dpi.inpe.br/terralib5/>



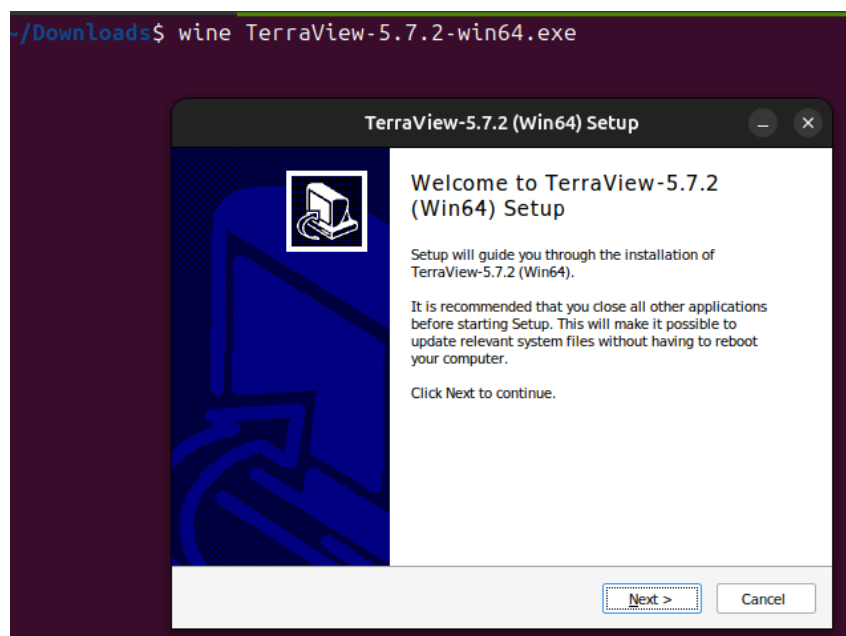
- To install Wine on Ubuntu follow the guidelines from the link below:

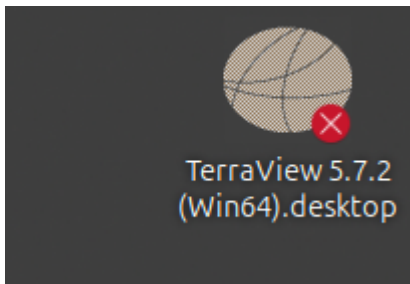
- Then, in a Linux terminal, type:

`wine TerraView-5.7.2-win64.exe`

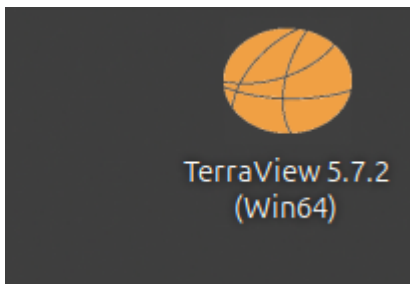
- Follow the installation instructions (equal to Windows installation, Next, Next, ...)



- At the end of the installation, TerraView icon will appear at the desktop, with a restriction:



- Right-click on and select "Allow Launching", the icon will become:



- Double-click on the TerraView icon, and the software will open normally.
